

A portrait of power: Doña Perón brings Evita's emotional story to life.

Alberta Ballet is pleased to welcome New York-based Ballet Hispánico to the stage with *Doña Perón*. This complex and moving portrait of Argentina's most controversial first lady, Eva "Evita" Perón, instantly captivated audiences across the continent when it premiered in 2022.

Following Evita's story from illegitimate child of a farmer, to dancehall girl, to Argentina's influential first lady, *Doña Perón* presents a portrait of dichotomies. Evita was an activist for the working class who also indulged in high-class opulence. She was a trusted figure among labourers, and an outcast snubbed by those in high-class society. *Doña Perón* presents the emotional story of this historical powerhouse, from her rise as an icon until her untimely death at the age of 33.

Choreographer Annabelle Lopez Ochoa brings her innovative vision to the Jubilee stage once again, following 2022/23's world premiere of *BOTERO*. Showcasing Ballet Hispánico's mission to explore Latin cultures in dance and infusing ballet with tango in this stunning contemporary work, Ochoa brings an exciting new perspective to the story. With lively music, complex costumes and thoughtful stage production, *Doña Perón* embodies power and emotion in an unforgettable masterpiece.





This double bill invites you into a dark and curious landscape of folklore, forest and frenzy against hard-hitting visceral scores.

Alberta Ballet presents two provocative works in a showcase of ballet beyond whimsy and grace.

The Rite of Spring's 1913 premiere shocked Paris audiences of the time, evoking more controversy and wielding more influence than almost any other piece of music or dance in history. Nicolo Fonte's 2014 version maintains the power and drama of the original, pairing Stravinsky's iconic score with a libretto that dives into themes of community, ritual sacrifice and birth and re-birth in subtle and abstract ways.

In 2021, Austria's Oper Graz premiered a distorted adult reimagining of the fairy tale, *Little Red Riding Hood*. In an exploration of temptation and threat, our folklore heroine is given three chances to shape the plot of this famous fable. A darker twist on the age-old tale, *Der Wolf* explores the struggle between dominance and devotion as a young woman deliberates on a choice.

Alberta Ballet School stands apart from other Canadian ballet schools, offering:






