Honouring the genius with a bold new vision

The daring triple-bill tribute honours Vaslav Nijinsky's revolutionary impact on ballet, refreshingly envisioned by acclaimed Canadian choreographers. Through the eyes of three female choreographers from three generations, this program reimagines two of Nijinsky's most legendary works—*Afternoon of a Faun* and *Petrushka*—bringing their groundbreaking ballet and raw emotion into a contemporary light. The program also includes *Firebird*, created during Nijinsky's early years with the Ballets Russes, a time when he was shaped by and contributed to the era's most influential works.

With deep reverence, choreographers and company artists bring Nijinsky's radical spirit to life. Expect inventive choreography that captures the essence of his works while infusing them with modern sensibilities and personal artistic flair, bridging past and present in celebration of a true icon of ballet. Reinterpretations by female artists offer a bold new perspective on the historic masterpieces from an era shaped by one of the most legendary male choreographers of all time.

Nijinsky is a conversation across time between a revolutionary era and today's artists. A landmark for true ballet lovers, this program sees legendary ballets reborn in the hands of today's creative talents.

Few ballets command the stage with the power and elegance of *Swan Lake*. The sweeping movement of the corps de ballet, the emotional depth of Odette and Siegfried's love story, and the tension of the Black Swan's deception make it one of the most captivating works in the classical repertoire. Alberta Ballet's production follows the beloved Petipa/Ivanov tradition while embracing the bold vision of Benjamin Pech, a former étoile of the Paris Opera Ballet. A ballet of love and destiny unfolds beneath the tower

Alberta Ballet closes the season with Notre Dame de Paris, a rarely seen masterpiece by Roland Petit. Based on Victor Hugo's novel, this ballet follows Esmeralda, a free-spirited dancer, and Quasimodo, the devoted bell-ringer, as they navigate love, obsession, and tragedy. With bold storytelling and breathtaking choreography, Notre Dame de Paris portrays desire, power, and sacrifice.

An unexpected fusion of dance, fashion, and theatrical brilliance sets this production apart. Petit's choreography captures Quasimodo's struggle and Esmeralda's spirit. Enhancing this legendary work are costumes designed by Yves Saint Laurent, inspired by Notre Dame's stained glass. Rich jewel tones and striking silhouettes bring medieval Paris to life, complemented by Maurice Jarre's evocative score, performed live.


